Over one million names are added per month!</p>	<p><i>Social Security Death Index</i></p> <p>The SSDI includes over fifty million names of people whose deaths were reported to the U.S. Social Security Administration beginning in 1937 (most records are from 1962 and later).</p>	<p><i>Vital Records Index</i></p> <p>Vital records are birth, marriage, and death records. The Vital Records Index covers: Denmark Finland Mexico Norway Sweden</p>	<p><i>Family History Web Sites</i></p> <p>This function suggests web sites that may be helpful.</p>	<p><i>Family History Library Catalog</i></p> <p>The FHLC is the card catalog to records in the Family History Library in Salt Lake City.
