

Way to Get Personal Ancestral File (PAF)

From the family history consultant.

1. The family history consultant should have a copy of the program that you can borrow to put on your computer.
2. They should also be able to help you install the program on your computer.

Check it out from the Family History Center.

1. To check PAF out from the Family History Center go to the Center located at 415 South 200 East in Springville.
2. Tell one of the workers that you would like to check the PAF program out to put on your home computer.
3. They will have you sign out a copy of the program.
4. You then take the program home and install it on your computer.
5. Remember to take the program back to the family history center.

Download it from the Internet

1. Go to www.familysearch.org .
2. At the top of the screen in the blue bar that goes across the screen, click on "Order/Download Products".
3. From the list click on "Software Downloads - Free".
4. The first item in the list should be the latest version of PAF, (if it's not the first item or you need a different version scroll down the list until you find the one you want) click on it.
5. Under the picture of the PAF program click on the button that says "Download".
6. Click the button that says "Continue" at the bottom of the screen.
7. Enter your information then click "submit".
8. Choose which language you want and click the "download" button beside it.

Buy the program (from Distribution Services or Deseret Book)

1. You can either go Distribution Services or order PAF online at www.ldscatalog.com . The cost is \$ 8.25.
2. At Deseret Book the cost is \$ 9.85.
